

Procedure for opening a New College

New Policy has been framed for opening a new college in the states. As per the new policy. 52 subdivisions headquarters with no colleges are chosen as lagging areas. For these lagging areas some concessions are offered which included 75% relaxation in FDR amount, a facility to use Secondary/Senior Secondary Schools in otherwise vacant second shift at a nominal rent of Rs. 100/- per month. The NOCs are given for starting colleges in these areas.

In other than lagging areas the procedure for opening new colleges is a two step process. As a first Step Letter of Intent will be issued to applicants aspiring to open colleges. Subsequently, on completion of building and necessary infrastructure, these institutes will be inspected by a three member committee. If found satisfactory, the NOCs be issued to start colleges. As a concession the colleges have been asked to complete the building and infrastructure facilities year wise in three year period.

Further, to enhance the participation of women in higher education it has been made mandatory to reserve 30% seats to women in the management committees of these colleges.

The previous procedure of issuing NOCs for subjects has been dropped and now the colleges can straight way opt subjects from affiliating universities.

The entire process of applying for opening new colleges right from beginning to issuing NOCs has been entrusted to the office of the Director, college education, Rajasthan. Submission of application form annexure 'A' with necessary documents and minimum prerequisite physical & financial conditions Annexure 'B'.
